

- 1. RULES
 - a. Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020
 - b. The prescriptions of the RYA will apply.
 - c. RRS 40.1 (personal Floatation Devices compulsory).
 - d. Competitors shall sign on and off.
- 2. ADVERTISING
 - a. In accordance with ISAF regulation 20.3(d) (i) boats shall display on each side of the bow while racing any advertising supplied by the event organiser at Registration
- 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
 - a. The event is open to
 - i. International Finn Class dinghies complying with the current Class rules.
 - ii. Firefly Class dinghies complying with the current Class rules.
 - b. Either the helm or crew shall be a member of the Finn / Firefly Class Association.
 - c. Entries shall be made on the Event Entry Form obtained from the KYC / BFA / NFA
 - d. The time limit for entries will be Registration on Saturday 08 July 2017
 - e. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.
- 4. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE
 - a. £30 if received before 01 July 2017 OR £35 on or after 01 July 2017
 - b. Cheques should be payable to Keyhaven Yacht Club with boat name and sail number on the reverse side of cheque
 - c. <u>Before 01 July 2017</u>
 - i. By Post Keyhaven Yacht Club, The Clubhouse, Keyhaven, Lymington Hampshire, SO41 0TR to reach KYC before July 01 2017. Please mark envelope KYC Finn + Firefly Open and include cheque for £30.00
 - ii. By Email to <u>rcsailingkyc@gmail.com</u> with payment of £30.00 by cheque or cash on Saturday 08 July before briefing. SUBJECT: FINN + FIREFLY OPEN 2017 KYC
 - d. After 01 July 2017
 - i. Completed Entry form and cheque / cash for £35.00 on Saturday 23 July before briefing.
- 5. REGISTRATION
 - a. Registration will take place in the KYC Club House from 07:30 till 09:00 on Saturday 08 July 2017.
- 6. BRIEFING
 - a. There will be competitors Briefings at 09:00 hrs on Saturday 08 July 2017 and 09:30 on Sunday 09 July 2017 outside the Clubhouse.
- 7. RACING
 - a. Six races are scheduled, not more than 4 races will be sailed on Saturday 08 July 2017
 - b. The time for the warning signal for the first race each day will be no earlier than 09:55am on Saturday 08 July 2017 and 10:25am on Sunday 09 July 2017.
 - c. No race will be started after 1500hrs on Sunday 09 July 2017
- 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
- a. Sailing Instructions will be available for download from the KYC / BFA / NFA from Thursday 06 July 2017
- 9. SCORING
 - a. RRS Appendix A Low Point will be used
 - b. Three completed races are required to constitute a series. When from 4 to 6 races have been completed,
 - a boats series score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.
- 10. VENUE
 - a. KYC Clubhouse The Clubhouse, Keyhaven, Lymington Hampshire, SO41 0TR.
 - b. Competitors will be temporary members for the duration of the regatta
- 11. COURSES
 - a. Racing will be in the Western Solent. Courses will be described by the Race Officer at the Briefing each day.
- 12. MEASUREMENT
 - a. Competitors and their boats shall comply with the International Finn Class / Firefly Class rules
 - b. Current Measurement Certificates may be required to be shown at Registration.
- 13. BOAT PARKING

- a. Boats shall be left in the KYC dinghy park or as directed by the Beach Master
- 14. CAR PARKING
 - a. There is a NFDC 'Pay and Display' Public Car Park adjacent to the KYC Club House

15. PRIZES

- 1. Finn Class
 - a. Prizes will be awarded to the first three (five for standard) boats in each of the following categories
 - i. Standard, ii Classic Carbon, iii Classic
 - b. the first boat in each of the following categories
 - i. Junior, ii Master, iii Grand Master, iv Great Grand Master, v Legend
- 2. Firefly Class
 - i. Prizes will be awarded to the first five boats in the class.
 - b. the first boat in each of the following categories
 - i. Junior (helm or crew), ii Lady (helm or crew)
- 3. Prize-giving will be in the Clubhouse at KYC as soon as possible after racing has been concluded on Sunday 09 July 2017

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- a. Competitors participate in any race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- b. Each competitor is responsible for ensuring their boat is equipped and seaworthy to face extremes of weather.
- c. The KYC, its members and those assisting in the race organisation will not accept any liability for material
- damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after any race. URANCE
- 17. INSURANCE
 - a. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.
- 18. RYA RACING CHARTER
 - a. The RYA Racing Charter shall be used as the basis of conduct during the Championship.
