### **Directions**

By Road - Proceed through Milford on Sea following signs to Keyhaven. Just after the NFDC car park turn left and follow the road for 150M where you will find the Club House.

### **Car Parking**

The Club car park is for members only. Visitors are asked to park in the NFDC car park adjacent to the Club. A Day Ticket is £8.00. Parking on the road in front of the Club House is temporary only.

### **Temporary Membership**

All persons who have completed an Entry Form will be granted Temporary Membership of the Club for them and their immediate families. Temporary Members cannot sign in non members.

### **Dinghy and Road Trailer Storage**

On arrival visiting sailors will be shown where to put their dinghy.

Storage of the dinghy, trolley and road trailer is entirely the risk of the owner. KYC will not be responsible for and loss or damage to a visiting dinghy, it's trolley or trailer.

The road trailer and trolley should be clearly marked with the sail number.

All dinghies arriving on road trailers must be stored on them with their trolleys.

## **Gear Store**

The Club has a Gear Store where you are welcome to leave any equipment overnight that you don't want to leave in your dinghy or take home. KYC will not be responsible for and loss or damage to any equipment left in the Gear Store. Ask any KYC member to open the Gear Store for you.

## **Washing Down**

There is a fresh water hose

- On the quay
- In front of the Club House.

When queuing to wash down or move your boat to or from the 'beach' please do not block the gate leading to the quay.

## **Quay and Beach**

We share the use of the beach with Hurst Castle sailing Club, commercial fishing boats their vehicles and other visitors to Keyhaven. Please be patient.

## **Dress Regulations**

Clean and tidy.

## **Changing Rooms**

Access from the main entrance. Please do not walk through the main Club House in wet sailing kit.

There are no lockers so please do not leave valuables in the changing rooms. Hot showers are available

## **Mobile Phones**

The use of mobile phone or similar devices for voice communication is not allowed within the Club House.

## **Food Service**

Food can be ordered from the bar. A menu board is on the wall adjacent to the 'short end' of the bar.

Visitors may consume their own food on the Club premises but they are expected to purchase all drinks from the bar when it is open.

## **Finn Firefly Regatta Pre-Order**

For the Finn + Firefly Regatta food may be pre –ordered using the ‘FF Food Pre-Order’ form which can be downloaded from the KYC Regatta website. Pre-ordered food forms MUST be received by 08:00 on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July.

- Lunch – choice of baguettes @ £3.50 / each
- Evening – ideally a BBQ (but if the weather dictates Lasagne and Salad) @ £5.50 / head.

## **Use of Members Galley**

Use of the Members Galley is allowed. Please keep it clean, leaving it as you found it having washed and dried and put away any equipment you have used.

There will be supplies of coffee / tea in the member’s galley for you to make hot drinks.

For anyone bringing their own food / drink there is a small fridge in the members galley which you are welcome to use.
