

### **Classic Finns report.**

Unfortunately, there has been no racing for Classic Finns this year as all the BFA Classics Travellers events and the CVRDA events had to be cancelled due to Covid-19. However, I continue to receive inquiries about Classic Finn restoration, rigging and sailing from the UK and around the world. In Britain two very early Finns which had long been thought lost recently turned up for sale, K17 and K19, both of which are now with new owners and being restored.

It was agreed at the recent BFA committee meeting that personal sail numbers of re-discovered Classic boats could be retained by the purchaser, unless the corresponding Classic Finn was likely to be raced at at the same BFA events.

We've also now added a dedicated section on the website for Classic Finns and this will gradually be populated with more articles and support for those sailing or restoring Classic Finns. There is also a Classic Finn section on the Forum, for Classic boat owners and restorers to ask questions and share their experiences with the rest of the Classic fleet.
