



1. RULES

- a. Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing **2021-2024**
- b. The prescriptions of the RYA will apply.
- c. RRS 40.1 (personal Floatation Devices – compulsory).
- d. Competitors shall sign on and off.
- e. Competitors shall be a fully paid up member of the BFA (British Finn Association)

2. ADVERTISING

- a. In accordance with ISAF regulation 20.3(d) (i) boats shall display on each side of the bow while racing any advertising supplied by the event organiser at Registration

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a. The event is open to
 - i. International Finn Class dinghies complying with the current Class rules.
- b. Either the helm or crew shall be a member of the Finn Class Association.
- c. Entries shall be made on the Event Entry Form obtained from the KYC / BFA
- d. The time limit for entries will be Registration on Saturday 30 April 2022
- e. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

4. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE

- a. **£40** - Cheques should be payable to Keyhaven Yacht Club with boat name and sail number on the reverse side of cheque.
 - i. By Post - Keyhaven Yacht Club, The Clubhouse, Keyhaven, Lymington Hampshire, SO41 0TR. Please mark envelope KYC Finn Masters and include cheque for £40.00

5. REGISTRATION

- a. Registration will take place in the KYC Club House from 08:00 on Saturday 30 April 2022.

6. BRIEFING

- a. There will be competitors Briefings at 09:00 hrs on Saturday 30 April 2022 and 09:00 on Sunday 1 May 2022 outside the Clubhouse.

7. RACING

- a. Six races are scheduled, not more than 4 races will be sailed on Saturday 30 April 2022
- b. The time for the warning signal for the first race each day will be no earlier than 09:55am on Saturday 30 April 2022 and 10:10am on Sunday 1 May 2022.
- c. No warning signal will be made after 14:30hrs on Sunday 01 May 2022

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Sailing Instructions will be available for download from the KYC / BFA / NFA from Thursday 07 April 2022

9. SCORING

- a. RRS Appendix A Low Point will be used
- b. Three completed races are required to constitute a series. When 6 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.

10. VENUE

- a. KYC Clubhouse - The Clubhouse, Keyhaven, Lymington Hampshire, SO41 0TR.
- b. Competitors will be temporary members for the duration of the regatta

11. COURSES

- a. Racing will be in the Western Solent. Courses will be described by the Race Officer at the Briefing each day.

12. MEASUREMENT

- a. Competitors and their boats shall comply with the International Finn Class rules.
- b. Current Measurement Certificates may be required to be shown at Registration.

13. BOAT PARKING

- a. Boats shall be left in the KYC dinghy park or as directed by the Beach Master

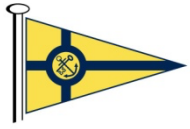
14. CAR PARKING

- a. There is a NFDC 'Pay and Display' Public Car Park adjacent to the KYC Club House

15. PRIZES

1. Finn Class
 - a. Prizes will be awarded to the first overall
 - b. the first three boats in each of the following categories
 - ii Master, iii Grand Master, iv Great Grand Master, v Legend
2. Prize-giving will be in the Clubhouse at KYC as soon as possible after racing has been concluded on Sunday 01 May 2022

17. INSURANCE

- a. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.

18. RYA RACING CHARTER

- a. The RYA Racing Charter shall be used as the basis of conduct during the Championship.
